

Veterans of Foreign Wars Ship 1774 Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, 12 June 2018

The meeting was called to order by Captain Jack Porath to conduct any and all business to come before the Ship. Following were conducted:

- Opening Ceremonies were held beginning 1800 hours which included the reading of Special Dates of Remembrance for this month.
- Roll call of officers was held and total attendance was eight shipmates.
- New and transfer applications were read and approved for processing.
- The Minutes of the last meeting will remain as published since there were no changes provided.
- Paymaster report was provided as audited and questions were answered.
- Service Officer Report (Alan Rein). No report.

Committee Reports:

- **Membership.** We are at 96.23%. The Captain provided that our youth is slow to recognize the benefits of joining. Also, he again reiterated that membership has a lot to do with keeping what we have fought for, all wars and generations. Membership is important as it retains our voice with our Nation's leaders, helps protect our earned benefits, and propels us to the future. Membership dues is \$45.00 per year; however, **Life Membership is very cost effective and ensures continuous membership.** The first payment for the 12 month pay option is \$45.00 (with 11 additional payments with the cost depending on your age). The Captain reiterated (again) that Life Membership is a much better option than maintaining Annual Membership status. If you are currently a yearly paid member, you can change to Life status and pay a monthly installment over a 12 month period or make other arrangements. The renewal date of annual pay members is the initial date of the dues payment. There is a continual fight in Congress concerning benefits, and belonging to a veterans' organization such as the VFW helps when Congress checks the membership stats. High membership=strong voice!
- **Buddy Poppy** (Captain) – Next distribution will be scheduled for the 4th of July holiday, probably the weekend of 30 June at Orchard Warehouse Supply (a new venue) located on Navaho Road.
- **Youth Development** (Scouting, JROTC, PP, VOD, etc) (Alan Rein). The VOD and PP 2019 themes are on the website.
- **Citizenship/Community Service** (Law Enforcement, Firefighter, EMT, Lifeguards, Teacher, Community Events) (Captain). For the sacrifices and extreme high-alert of our police officers, keep them in your prayers.
- **Student Veterans and Iraq/Afghanistan Veterans.** (Alan Rein). No report.
- **House** (Captain). The details of events presented at the meeting are separately published and posted on the bulletin-board and web site.
- **National Home for Children** (Captain). Captain emphasized Life Membership (\$40.00) that helps the children. Current members and those who are wanting or selected to join need not be members of the VFW to be awarded a membership. Alan Rein's Ship 1774 purchased Life Membership is being processed by the National Home.
- **United Veterans Council** (Alan Rein). Monthly meeting of the United Veterans Council, to which anyone can attend, will be held at 0930 for the dates: 23 Jun, 28 Jul, 25 Aug, 22 Sep, 27 Oct, 24 Nov. - **Legion Riders.** Want to join the Legion Riders Chapter we are forming? You must be a member of the American Legion, dues \$45.00 per year to which all VFW members are eligible to join. - All prayed to remember the National Home for Children.

UNFINISHED AND OLD BUSINESS.

- In the April 2017 business meeting, motion was made, seconded and all approved to allow for the purchase of a web service that would allow the finding of persons who may have moved or passed away. Such information is needed to update the membership database. A no-cost web site was offered that will be fully researched before a paid web site is obtained. Issue is still pending.
- La Mesa Flag Day Parade was a tremendous success. Eight cars and seven motorcycles. A terrific showing. Immediately afterward, the Legion Riders agreed this is a fun event and they expressed an interest in again joining us next year.
- Flag placement on Memorial Day at the El Cajon cemetery was a huge success. Cleaning, repairing, and inventorying next year's flags on Wed 20 June in the upper hall, 1300 hours. All are welcome to assist.

NEW BUSINESS.

- The proposed 2018-2019 budget was introduced, discussed, and approved with the understanding that the income must match the disbursements. Reductions with income will necessitate cuts in the disbursements, but the approved budget will provide needed flexibility.
- Sam Aleto discussed the upcoming Poker event in the main hall on 25 August. More to follow, but everyone is encouraged to assist with ticket selling.
